

The Birthplaces of French Saints Logic Puzzle



The four saints listed in this puzzle were all born in France. You have to match the place of birth and parents' names to each saint. Read the following clues carefully. Put an "x" in a box to represent no; a "." to represent yes. If you don't know how to solve logic table puzzles, [see our guide](#). Since these are all real-life facts, you could look them up if you get stumped and need more hints. But the puzzle is able to be solved without looking up any more information.

- John Eudes was born in the village of Ri. Théophane Vénard wasn't born in Cuvilly.
- Catherine Labouré was either the daughter of Pierre or was born in Cuvilly.
- The name of the *birthplace* of Jean-François' daughter starts with a letter that is earlier in the alphabet than the starting letter of the *birthplace* of the daughter of Madeleine Louise. (Careful with this clue! It is tricky, but you can get a lot more information out of it that you might think at first!)
- Catherine Labouré's mother is not named Martha
- Julie Billiard's mother's name is longer than the names of any of the other saints' mothers.
- The saint born in Saint-Loup-sur-Thouet did not have a name starting with a "C".
- Jean and Marie's child was not born in Ri.
