BORN: October 27, 1809 in Tilburg, Netherlands

DIED: January 14, 1887 in Batavia, Suriname

◆ As a child, he taught catechism.

◆ He could not afford to go to school for very long.

◆ He became a servant to the seminarians.

◆ When he was 22, he was declared unfit for military service.

◆ When he was 24, he tried to join the Redemptorists and was denied.

◆ He was also denied by the Jesuits and Franciscans.

◆ A benefactor paid for him to go to seminary.

◆ He entered seminary when he was 28 years old.

◆ He served as a missionary to Suriname for 45 years.

◆ He took care of the oppressed.

◆ He attended the sick during an epidemic.

◆ He took care of 600 lepers for 30 years.

◆ He entered the Redemptorists when he was 57.

◆ He studied music to cheer sick children.





SURINAME

- Suriname is the smallest independent country in South America.
- It is the only independent country outside Europe where Dutch is the primary language of government.
- Its main export is gold.
- Suriname is the most forested country in the world. (98.3% of the county is forest.)
