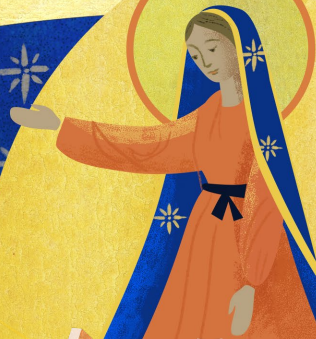

Rules for the August Liturgical Calendar Game

There are two different ways to play the game this month.

For the simple version, players start at the bottom of the ladder before August 1st. Roll a die and move the number of spaces rolled. If you land next to a rope, you can choose to slide across to the other ladder on the same turn. Movement is always up the first ladder and then down the other until you reach the bottom. If you choose to use a rope, continue on in the correct direction for that ladder. When you reach the 31st, treat the 1st as if it is the next space. Continue to ascend and descend until you have collected eight different saint tokens (or all sixteen for longer play). You gain a token if you land on the saint's date. If you land on the 6th, 15th or 22nd, you can choose any saint without landing on their date

(or answering a question if you're playing the trivia version). When you have collected all your saint friends, go to the top of the ladder, and Mary will help you to reach Jesus in Heaven.

For the trivia version, you will need a trivia master who will read the questions. When you land on a saint space, you will receive a random saint question. The answer can be any of the 16 August saints. If you answer correctly, collect the token for the date you are on and your turn ends. If you are not correct, your turn ends. Follow the movement rules for the simple version. When you have collected eight saints, advance to the top of the ladder, and Mary will help you to reach Jesus in Heaven.
